Description of Unit

Peile Centre is a provision for students in Key Stages 3 and 4 who primarily have cognition and learning needs.

There are two classes split between Key Stage 3 and Key Stage 4.

The students are on the roll of Chantry Academy, but the centre is staffed by EEG SEND specialist teachers.



Overview

Peile is a specialist provision for young people with primarily cognition and learning needs. These young people may have been in a mainstream setting prior to joining Peile and can access some of the learning and social opportunities offered by the main school. These young people do not require a place in a special school but do benefit from a smaller setting and a bespoke timetable.

It is expected that the young person will access parts of the mainstream curriculum and will make some subject choices in Key Stage 4.

All the young people have an EHCP and places are provided by the local authority.
