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## **Description of Unit**

Peile unit is for Students of Secondary age with Cognition and Learning needs.

The unit is based on two classes of 9 Students. One class for Key Stage 3 (years 7-9) and the second class for Key Stage 4 (10 and 11)

The students are on the school roll of Chantry Academy. The staff are employed by SENDAT. SENDAT runs a number of special schools and is working in partnership with Chantry Academy.

## Overview

Peile is specialist provision for young people with Cognition and Learning needs which cannot always be met in mainstream, but are not requiring a special school place.

Until Easter 2022 Peile is based in Murrayside Community Centre on Nacton Road.

When fully open we expect that eventually students will spend approximately half their time in the unit and the other time in mainstream lessons. We will co-produce each student's timetable with parents and carers to build on the strengths and interest of each student.

It is likely that students will have spent some time in mainstream and been successful with building friendships but need some support with their learning.

The staffing allows for students to have support in mainstream lessons. In most cases students will receive English, Maths and Personal development in the unit and access mainstream lessons for some areas of the curriculum where they have an interest and or aptitude.
