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SPC Explained



How to read SPC charts

Statistical Process Control (SPC) charts help show how a process or measure changes over time, and highlight results that may need further attention.

Because data will naturally vary, SPC helps distinguish normal variation from more meaningful change. These charts look similar to standard line charts, but also include additional elements.

Centre line = mean (average)

Upper and lower control limits = the range within which values would usually be expected to fall

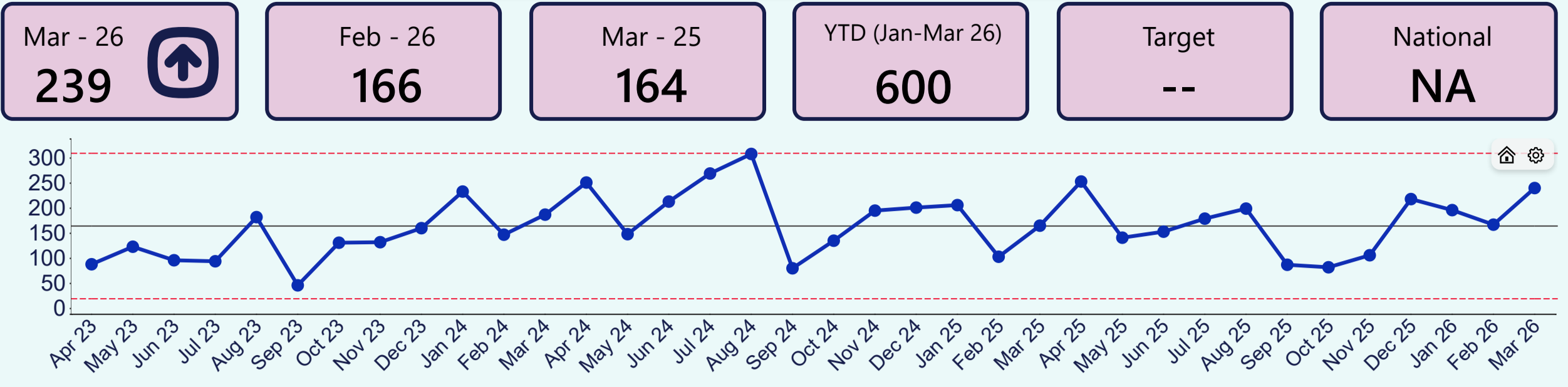
Arrow in the top-left = whether increasing values are good, decreasing values are good, or whether neither applies

These help to show whether a result is within the expected range or may need further investigation.

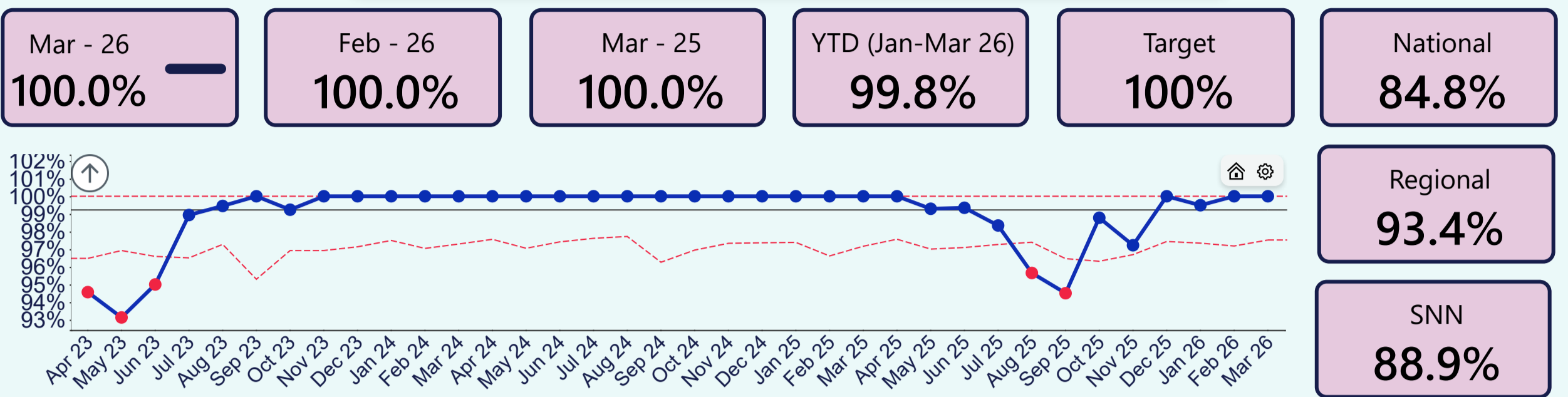
Some data in this report is not suitable for SPC, for example where values follow a continuous trend over time. In these cases, the mean and control limits have been removed, and the chart should be read in the same way as a standard line chart.

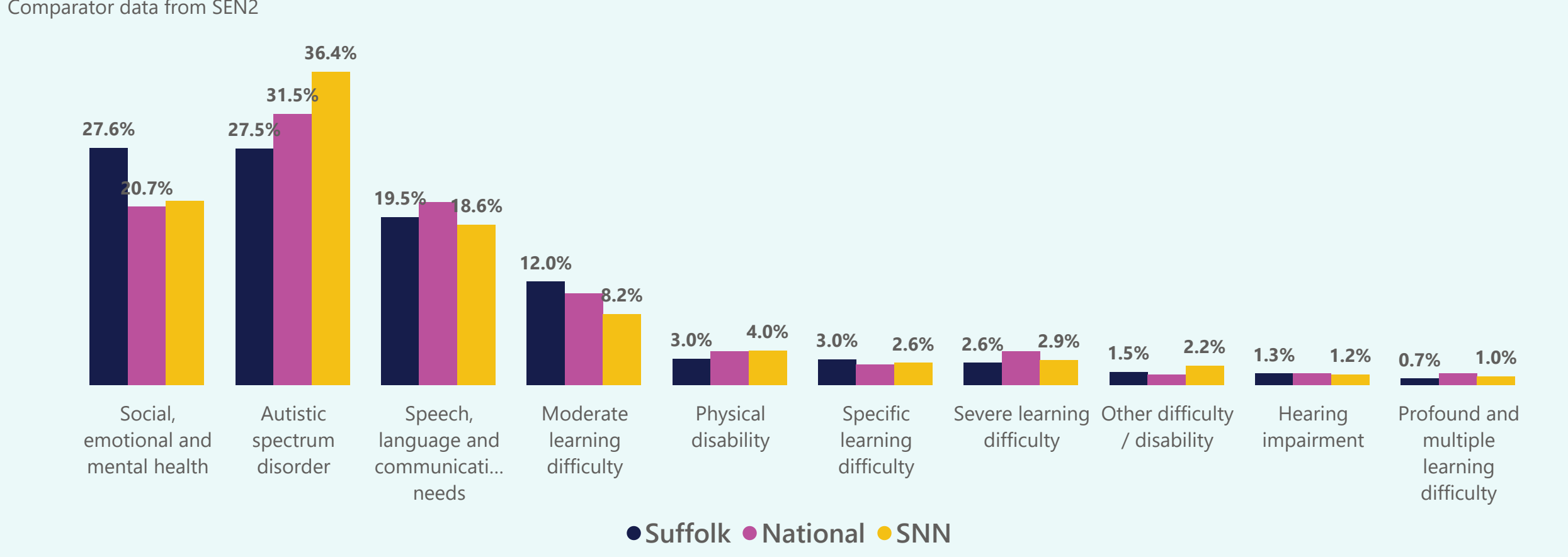
4) Trend - Count of Open EHCPs - Top 5 Primary Needs



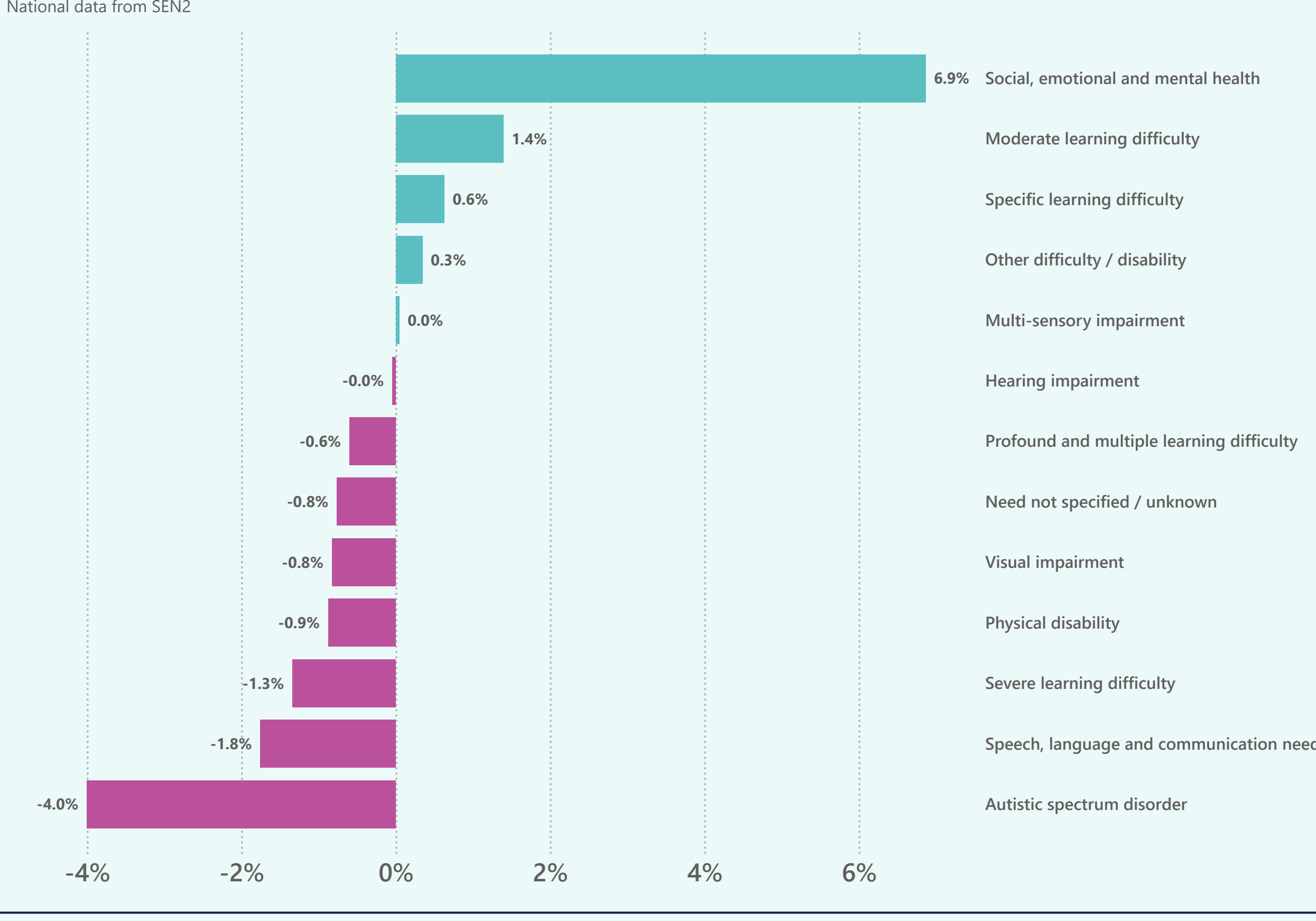

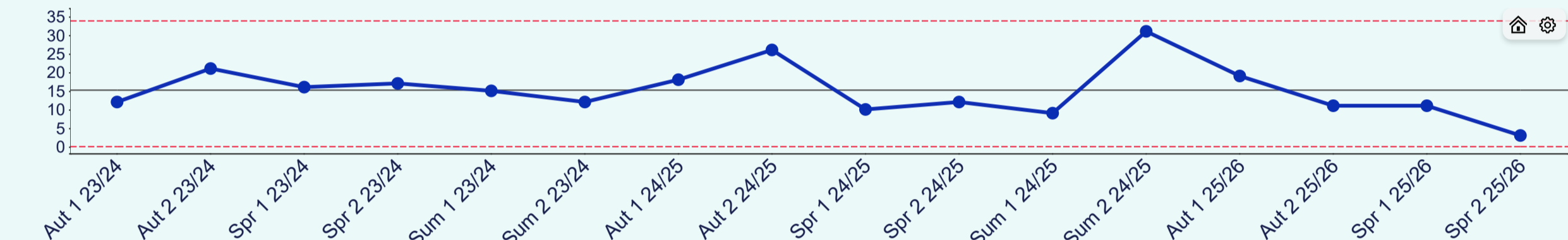


3) Trend - Top Primary Needs of Started PEX - SEN Support



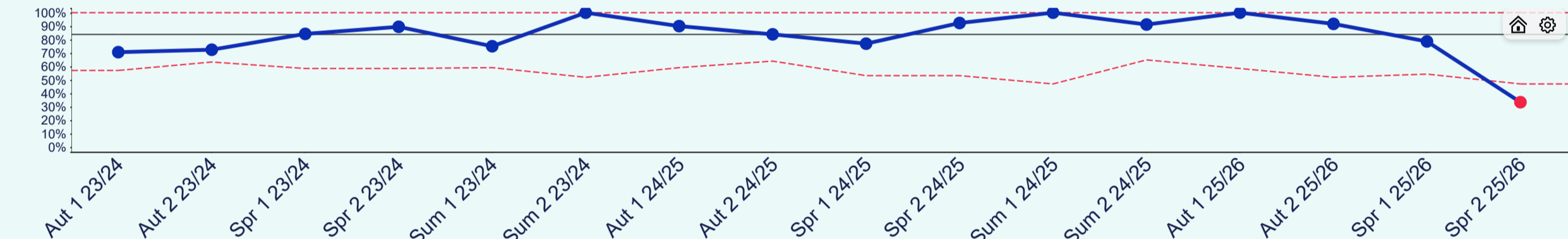
